1. Reference is made to Department of the Army letter, file reference: AGPO-XD 201 Jones, Delmos J. (27 Mar 59), dated 12 June 1959, which furnished information regarding your fitness for service in the Army Establishment.

2. A study of the proceedings in your case by the Department of the Army has resulted in a determination that your acceptance for military service in any component of the United States Army or appointment in the United States Army Reserve is inconsistent with the interests of national security. This information is based on your failure to satisfactorily rebut or explain the following allegations:

a. You were a member of the Labor Youth League in San Francisco, California, and in 1955 and 1956 you were a member of, held office, attended meetings and functions, and paid dues in the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Club of the Labor Youth League in Los Angeles, California. The Labor Youth League has been cited as a Communist organization by the Attorney General of the United States.

b. In 1952 and 1953 you were a member of and attended meetings of the Writer's Workshop of the East Bay Youth Cultural Center. The East Bay Youth Cultural Center was created by the Labor Youth League in the fall of 1952 for the purpose of recruiting new members into the Labor Youth League.

c. In 1954 you were a member of the staff, subscribed to, submitted stories for publication, and attended meetings of the Pacific Coast Youth Recorder. The Pacific Coast Youth Recorder was a Marxist newspaper published monthly in Los Angeles, California, whose policies as of 1954 were dominated by the Labor Youth League.

d. You have purchased copies of, and in 1954, 1955 and 1957 you attended affairs sponsored by the "Peoples' World" in San Francisco, California. The "Peoples' World" has been cited as the official organ of the Communist Party on the West Coast by the Special Committee on Un-American Activities of the House of Representatives.

e. In 1951 and 1952 you attended meetings of the Civil Rights Congress in Richmond, California. The Civil Rights Congress has been cited as subversive and Communist by the Attorney General of the United States.

f. In 1957 you attended meetings of the California Labor School in San Francisco, California. The California Labor School has been cited as a subversive and Communist organization by the Attorney General of the United States.

g. In 1958 you attended a meeting of the Socialist Workers Party in San Francisco, California. The Socialist Workers Party has been cited as a subversive and Communist organization by the Attorney General of the United States.

h. On 19 September 1958 you materially falsified Department of Defense Form 98 (Armed Forces Security Questionnaire), an official document by failing to list thereon your membership and activities in the Labor Youth League.

i. On 19 September 1958 you materially falsified Department of Defense Form 398 (Statement of Personal History), an official document, by failing to list in items 16, 17 and 19, your membership and activities in the Labor Youth League, the East Bay Youth Cultural Center, the Pacific Coast Youth Recorder; your attendance at meetings and functions of the Peoples' World, the Civil Rights Congress, the California Labor School, The Socialist Workers Party; and your association with members of the Communist Party.

j. You maintain a close and continuing association with Paula Krotser, who since at least 1955 has been a member of and held office in the Communist Party in Santa Cruz and Monterey Counties, California.

k. You maintain a close and continuing association with George Raymond Krotser, who since at least 1955 has been a member of the Communist Party.

3. Pursuant to paragraph 34e, Army Regulations 604-10, you may submit a further explanation of your case, together with additional supporting statements and affidavits, within twenty (20) days of receipt of this letter of notification. If you do not respond within 20 days, the determination set forth above will become final. If you do respond, the entire file will be reconsidered together with your reply and a final decision rendered.
